ENTRY INFORMATION

Entries close at 6pm on August 16th at the Test Secretary's address. Entries received after this date and time will be returned. Checks will not be cashed until after closing!! For entries received by the closing date, the class level of their entry may be changed until 6:00pm on August 23rd by sending an email to info@boonecountydogsport.com. If you send an email, and do not receive a confirm of change, please call the trial secretary.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge on all returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made by cash/money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check where notification is received after event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entries. No reinstatement of results is possible. All awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is cancelled without recourse by owner/handler.

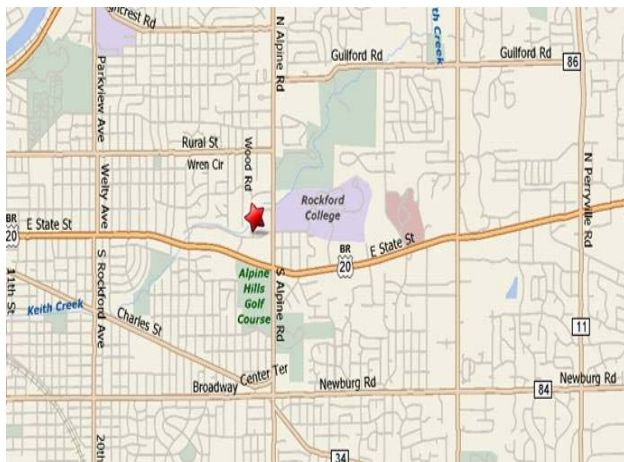
- ◆ **Overpayment of entry fees** of \$10 or greater only will be refunded at the event.
- ◆ **Express entries** must have a release allowing them to be delivered without signature. The club will not be responsible for delivery delays.
- ◆ **Entry forms** must be complete, legible, signed, and accompanied by the correct entry fees. Errors will be resolved via email.

CHECK IN START-TIMES: Grounds open on Friday at 10:00am. Check-in/measuring will be from 11:30am—noon, followed by a general briefing for all competitors at 12:15, judges' briefings at 12:30 with judging to begin promptly at 1:00pm. Grounds will open on Saturday and Sunday at 7:00am. Check-in/measuring will be from 7:30am—7:45am, followed by a general briefing for all competitors at 7:45, judges' briefings at 8:00 with judging to begin promptly at 8:30am. *Times are tentative, check your confirmation for any changes to this schedule.*

All competitors must check in on their first day of competition. All dogs must be measured unless the dog is jumping 26" (22" in Perf.), the handler presents a permanent card, temporary card with 3 signatures awaiting a CMJ or check-in letter issued by USDAAA/print out of dog info page from subscriber account indicating the dog is permanently carded. Please send a copy of your yellow permanent height card with your entry so I will have it on file permanently.

FOOD: There will be light breakfast fare (fruit, donuts, coffee, pop, etc.) and lunch for sale at the site.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st place through 3rd place in the Championship & Performance classes in each jump height and in mini and open divisions for pairs. Maroon qualifying rosettes will be awarded to those dogs earn qualifying scores. Grand Prix & Performance Grand Prix placement rosettes will be awarded for 1st place through 3rd place in each jump height. "Bye" vouchers to advance to Round 2 of a regional championship will be awarded to 1st place qualifiers. Competitors earning qualifying scores will receive a double maroon & white (Grand Prix) or double maroon & pink (PGP) qualifying ribbon. Steeplechase and Perf. Speed Jumping details regarding prize money offered for Round 2 can be found in the class descriptions on the USDAAA website. Team / Versatility Pairs will have gold, silver and bronze medallions awarded to the 1st through 3rd teams/pairs overall. All qualifying teams /pairs members will receive a lapel pin in recognition of their qualification. See class descriptions online for details.

A registration card and number with a "U" prefix will be issued to facilitate entry at USDAA® events, and tracking of show results in regular classes. Junior Handlers (those 18 years of age and younger) and their dogs must be separately registered for participation in the USDAA's Junior Handler Program (UJHP). A registration number with the "J" prefix will be assigned for use in entering UJHP events. A Dog that is expected to compete in both programs (regular classes and UJHP) must be registered separately for each program. CLASS DESCRIPTIONS AND ELIGIBILITY

The following titling classes are being offered at the Starters, Advanced, Masters and Performance 1, 2, and 3 levels at this event: Gamblers, Jumpers, Pairs Relay, Snooker and Standard. A complete description of these classes and the requirements for eligibility for entry may be found in Chapters 3 - 7 of the Official USDAA Rules & Regulations, which are incorporated in this test schedule by reference. A summary of eligibility requirements for all titling classes is presented in Appendix E of the Rules & Regulations. Note that effective 1/1/09, Pairs will be required for versatility titles in Performance. Should only one dog be entered in a program/level, a partner from another program/level may not be solicited to make a qualifying pair.

The following 2010 tournament qualifiers are being offered at this event. Descriptions have been edited to save space. All competitors are eligible for entry to these classes.

Grand Prix of Dog Agility® World Championships & Performance Grand Prixsm Championships Local Qualifiers: These single-round tournaments are open to all dogs regardless of skill level or titles earned and are judged under Masters rules. Competitors earning ZERO faults shall earn a qualifying score. The first place dog/handler in each jump height earning a qualifying score will be awarded a 'bye' in the final round of a Regional Championship. One qualifying score is required to enter Round 1 of a Regional Championship and two (2) qualifying scores are required to enter the quarterfinals at the world championships.

Dog Agility Steeplechase® & Performance Speed Jumpingsm: These two-round tournaments are open to all dogs regardless of skill level or titles earned and are judged under modified Starters rules. A qualifying score is earned in Round 1. In Steeplechase one qualifying score is required to enter Round 1 of a Regional qualifier and two scores are required to enter the quarterfinals at the world championships. A 'bye' may be earned in Round 2 of a regional championship. In Speed Jumping two (2) qualifying scores are required for entry into the semifinals at the world championships.

Dog Agility Masters® Team & Performance Versatility Pairssm : Both tournaments include five classes judged under Masters rules in which points are accumulated. Classes include standard, snooker, gamblers, jumpers and relay. One qualifying score is required for entry in the world championships.

The handler of a dog entered in Team/PVP that measures up must notify the secretary at check in. Should the change of height impact the number of jump heights on a team, the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from the dogs available. The dog measured up must jump at the higher height in order for the team/pair to earn a qualifying score. If the dog runs FEO at the lower height, the team/pair may not qualify, but the partners may earn placements, top ten points and Lifetime Achievement Qs in the individual classes.

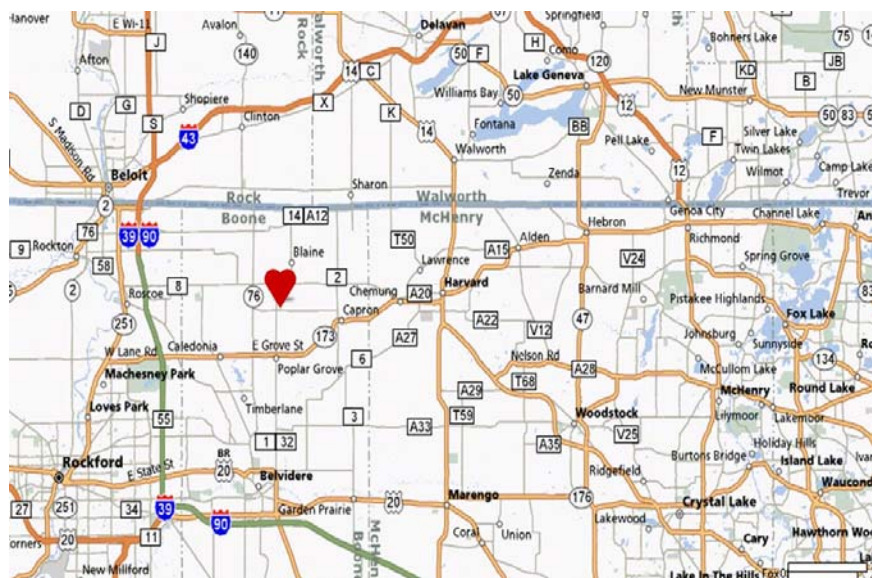

SITE INFORMATION

Outdoor shade is minimal - tenting is suggested. Parking will be along the east side of the rings on the grass and along the driveway facing the lake. The test site will be available for set-up on Friday starting at 10:00am till around 8:00pm or when it gets dark, but only after the rings, club tent, and score table areas are set-up. If you set-up too early, your stuff may be moved! Hotels grounds/facility are also considered part of the site grounds for the test weekend. Please be considerate and pick-up after you and your dog at the hotels. Competitors and spectators are expected to keep the trial and hotel site grounds clean. Anyone witnessed not picking up after his/her dog will be excused from the test weekend with no monies refunded. The Organizing Committee is not responsible for any loss or damage to items at the match site.

2011 IFCS World Agility Competition

As the U.S. representative of IFCS, USDAA will be sending a team to Europe for the 2011 World Agility Competition. To kick off the fund-raising, USDAA asks that you consider making a donation. All monies donated in this manner will be put directly into a fund for the entire team. If you wish to make a donation, please include a separate check payable to USDAA and mark the entry form.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors, though submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- ◆ This test is open to all USDAA-registered dogs being at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.
- ◆ All dogs must be registered with USDAA in order to compete. Registration may be included with entry to this trial (a registration form is included in this test schedule) or be obtained at www.USDAA.com, General Information.
- ◆ Dogs that measure up will be placed first in the higher height. Should the dog be unprepared for the higher height, it may be run For Exhibition Only, but no awards or qualifying scores may be earned. No change in program is permitted at check-in.
- ◆ No leads, collars, toys, food or other training aids will be permitted on the course.
- ◆ Safety of the dogs, handlers, and spectators must always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by the handlers.
- ◆ The Organizing Committee may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any Committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy sent to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.
- ◆ No refunds will be made after the closing date, or in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or the club, or barred from competition by action of the Organizing Committee. In addition, no entry fees will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the club.
- ◆ Refunds for injured dogs or bitches in season will be eligible for a refund, less USDAA fees, judges fees, and a \$10 service fee per day, if the Test Secretary is notified by August 23rd AND a note from a veterinarian is received (emails accepted). No other withdrawals after the closing date will be eligible for a refund. You will know that you are due a refund because you will receive an email stating so on or before August 24th.
- ◆ A copy of the USDAA rulebook may be viewed online at www.USDAA.com.
- ◆ **FAULT LIMITS MAY BE APPLIED** at the discretion of the Organizing Committee AND judge, and will be announced in the judge's briefing.
- ◆ Obstacles will meet the requirements of USDAA rules and regulations. There will be NO obstacle familiarization at this event. ALL Dogs present must be held on leash or other wise confined except when being judged or in the Warm-up area. If you are caught in violation with this rule, you will be excused from the Test weekend.
- ◆ Cooperation and abidance of facility rules will assist us in being welcomed back. By signing the general agreement you promise to follow these rules or be excused from the grounds.
- ◆ Test will be run outdoors, on grass, rain or shine. There is ample room for tents, crating, and chairs outdoors. Please be advised to bring proper equipment to shade your dog or otherwise shelter your dog, in case of inclement weather. Puppy pens must have something under them to keep any pee/poop from discoloring the lawn and can be set-up on the north side of the driveway. Parking and tent set-up will be limited to the marked areas only. Dog potty areas will be clearly marked. Anyone not using the marked are will be asked to leave and will forfeit their entry for the weekend.
